Memorisation of fixed texts

- Memorisation techniques in Vedic oral tradition
 - Samhitā-pāțha: words in sequence as pronounced
 - Pada-pāțha : words in sequence in pausa form
- Other pāthas, each word in samhitā and in pausa form:
 - Krama-pāțha : 12 23 34 45 56, etc.
 - Jața-pāțha : 1221 12 2332 23 3443 34 4554 45, etc.
 - Ghana-pāțha : 1221 123 321 123 2332 234 432 234 3443 345 543 345, etc.

Petrification of texts and oral tradition

- Oral compositions crystallise and petrify and are transmitted verbatim
- OAv. texts petrified while composition in performance continued
- OAv. texts integrated into and elaborated on in later oral compositions




Avestan and Middle Persian exegetical traditions

- Methods of creating new letters for the Av. alphabet:
 - by adding diacritic marks to existing letters
 - by borrowing letters from other scripts




